Operæ invites designers, design studios, handicraft designers, makers and graphic designers to exhibit and participate with their own self-production to the fourth edition of the event, that will be held in Torino from the 11th to the 13th of October 2013.

After its success in 2012, Operæ once more establishes itself as one of the main appointments where to **exhibit products and collections**, meet new Italian design talents and well-known artists, as well as delve into the role of design in our contemporary society by the means of debates, meetings and workshops. A winning format that has been turned into a real festival for independent design.

Operæ is a **platform where to meet, share and grow** dedicated to the self-production world which aim is to promote independent design, establish new relationships with and between designers, and discuss on the cultural, economic and social implications of independent design. Operae is addressed to specialized operators – designers that blend design research, technology and tradition, by managing the entire production chain by their own or collaborating with artisans, small and medium-sized enterprises or laboratories with digital equipments – distributors, students and general public.

Exhibitors will have their own stand for displaying and selling their own products. Operæ offers its exhibitors the opportunity to participate in **meetings with potential distributors** such as shop managers, concept stores, galleries, showrooms, Italian and international shop-on-line. The rich cultural program consists in **conferences and workshops**, an occasion for growing and learning together with well-known personalities belonging to the design panorama.

This fourth edition will be held in the premises of the **Officine Grandi Riparazioni of Torino**, an example of industrial architecture which dates back to the XIX century, recently renovated and turned into an exhibition space.
